Description

The team will work together to create a Web site based on the assigned topic.

Topic

Your team is to create a public service announcement (PSA) web site about the topic of your choice. This web site is to promote your cause and provide information to support your argument. The site is to have more than one page and may include content in multiple media formats. While the site may have external links to other sites the majority of the information about the message must be present in the team's site.

Possible topics may include:

- Drug addiction
- Stop smoking
- Drinking and driving
- Healthy eating
- Bullying
- Youth exercise
- Distracted driving

Teams who do not submit an entry that follows the topic above will be disqualified.

JUDGING PROCEDURE

- Teams will be introduced by team number. **Contestants may continue to wear their name badges.**
- As a team of judges, formulate two to three questions to ask at the conclusion of the presentation. Be sure to ask the same questions of each team.
- Teams will present before a panel of judges and timekeeper.
- The length of set-up will be no more than five (5) minutes.
- The length of the presentation will be no more than ten (10) minutes; followed by judges' questions not to exceed five (5) minutes.
- Excuse teams upon completion of judges' questions.
- **There can be no ties in the top ten (10) teams.** It is the responsibility of the judges to break any ties.
- Administrator will fill out ranking sheet prior to dismissing the judges.
- If more than one (1) section is necessary, finalists will be determined by selecting an equal number from each section.
- Give administrator all Judges' Scoring Rubrics, Judge Comment Sheets and contest materials.
- No audience is allowed in the contest room.
